



Our October meeting speaker is author Paul Bretzger discussing his book "Observing Hancock at Gettysburg: The General's Leadership through eyewitness accounts".

Paul E. Bretzger is the author of *Observing Hancock at Gettysburg: The General's Leadership through Eyewitness Accounts*, recipient of the Gettysburg Civil War Round Table's 2017 Distinguished Book Award. He grew up in Eatontown, New Jersey, and received a B.A. of Historical Studies degree at Stockton University before earning a Master of Architecture degree from N.J.I.T. Paul worked as an architect in New York City for two decades. There, he contributed to the design of such buildings as the residence of New York Mets majority owner, Steve Cohen.

But recently, he has returned to his native state as a teacher of Computer Aided Drafting and Design (CADD), and architecture and engineering theory.
