JSCWRT member Andy Megill, pictured with the 69th New York State Volunteers shooting team at the Fall Nationals of the North-South Skirmish Association (N-SSA). Held just north of Winchester, Virginia on October 1, 2 & 3, this was the first National competition since before the Covid pandemic. The team won 3rd place in the musket team match out of 33 entries in their team's class, the second most competitive of six classes for team competition with original and reproduction Civil War rifle-muskets and rifles. The N-SSA is a nation-wide competitive shooting organization with individual and team matches using original and repro firearms and artillery from the Civil War. In addition to the musket team matches, the 69th NYSV team competes in the smoothbore musket, carbine and mortar team matches. Other competitions include breechloader, revolver and artillery, among others. Participating in the N-SSA is a great way to combine an interest in the Civil War and the shooting sports.
