Larry Korczyk has been a Licensed Battlefield Guide at Gettysburg National Military Park for 10 years. He passed the National Park Service licensed guide exam in March of 2013. Prior to this, he worked for 30+ years in the logistics industry as a manager at two large distribution centers. However, always having a love of history, particularly on the American Civil War, he joined a Civil War Round Table in his native state of New Jersey, became an active Civil War reenactor for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Rhode, has conducted Island Infantry, and dreamed- after his first visit to Gettysburg in 1990- to become a Licensed Battlefield Guide. Today, he lives in Gettysburg, has given hundreds of tours on the battlefield, is a regular speaker at Civil War Round Tables, and has co-authored a book titled "Top Ten at Gettysburg"


