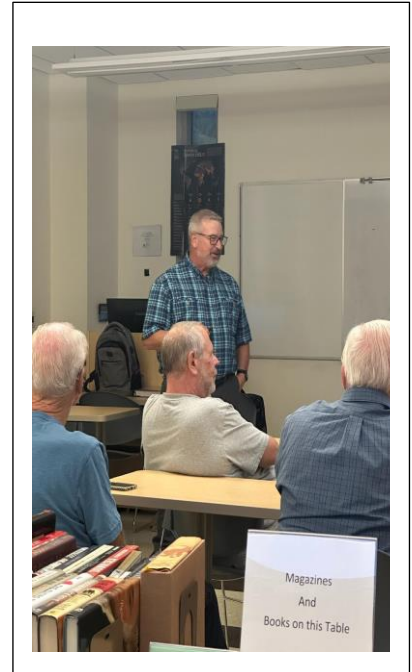

ARMISTEAD AND HANCOCK: Behind the Gettysburg Legend of Two Friends at the Turning Point of the Civil War

A lifelong student of history, Tom McMillan has served on the board of trustees of Pittsburgh's Heinz History Center, the board of directors of the Antietam Institute and the marketing committee of the Gettysburg Foundation. He has written four books on American history, including two on the Battle of Gettysburg and two on the Armistead family. Tom recently retired after a forty-three-year career in sports communications -- as a newspaper writer, radio talk show host, and, for 25 years, vice president of communications for the NHL's Pittsburgh Penguins. He resides with his wife, Colleen, and their cats, Boris and Natasha, in both Pittsburgh and Gettysburg.

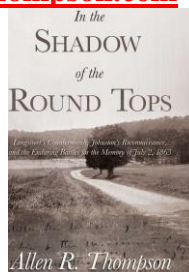
NEWS AND UPCOMING EVENTS
