Our Speaker for January is Colin Zimmerman speaking to us on *General Winfield Scott*

Colin is the Military Historian for Washington Crossing Park in Pennsylvania. He has published works in the Journal of the American Revolution, Gettysburg Magazine, Cedar Creek Battlefield Foundation, and Shenandoah Valley Battlefield Foundation.

Colin has had the privilege to serve in the United States Army as a Cavalry Scout for 6 years. Colin earned his Master's degree in military history from Norwich University where his thesis focused on the grand strategic situation of the fall of 1862. He is finishing up his PhD from Liberty University where his focus is on the American Revolution, specifically the British strategic focus during the Monmouth Campaign in 1778.

Bob Meany is standing in the doorway of the prison cell where Confederate President Jefferson Davis was held prisoner after his capture in May of 1865. January Trivia Question: He was a brigadier general and former law partner of President James Polk. He was suspended from commanded after the "Fort Donelson debacle". Who is this man?



The JSCWRT meets the second Wednesday of the month at 7PM on the campus of Ocean County College


- This month we will be meeting January 10th 7 pm in Bartlett Hall, Room 203 and simultaneously on WebEx unless otherwise noted.
