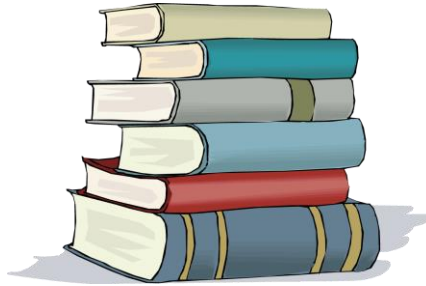


October Trivia Question: What was the name of Jefferson Davis's last home, which after his death became a home for Confederate veterans and their wives and is now a museum?
