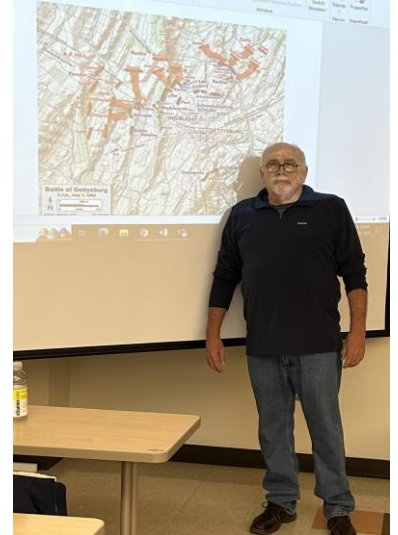
Our speaker for May is Greg Caggiano

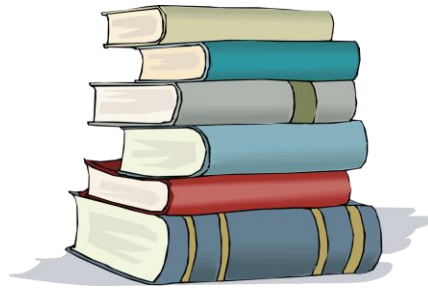
