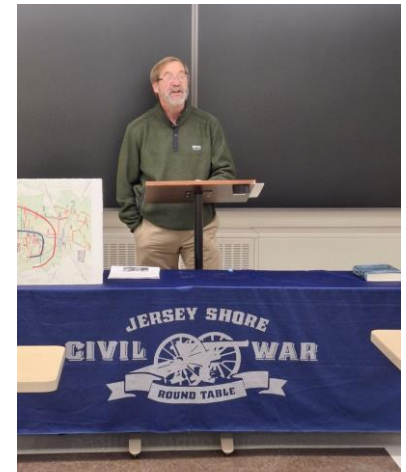

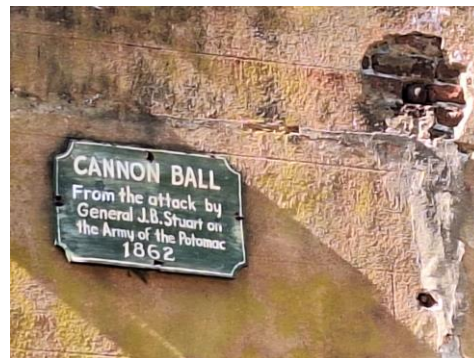

## MONTHLY TRIVIA QUESTION!

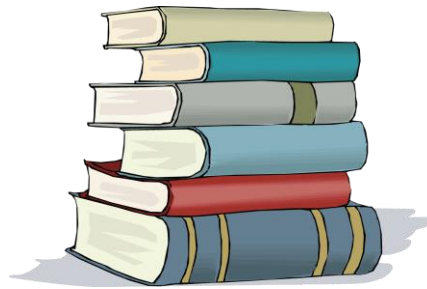
February Trivia: What important visitor did General McClellan deliberately avoid in November 1861 by going to bed instead of meeting with him?
